



## 2026 Rebus New Zealand AGM - Hibiscus Coast

### **Transport - Auckland International Airport [AIA] to City and vice versa.**

It is 21 km from the airport to downtown Auckland city. Choices for transport are taxi, shuttle, bus, or bus/train. A taxi will cost \$75 - \$95 each way. An Uber will cost less - their pickup zone is in lane 2 near Door 2 at the Domestic Terminal. The shuttle is slightly cheaper than a taxi at \$60 - \$85. The bus/train takes about 75 minutes.

The best option with the most frequent schedule is the SkyDrive Airport Express. This is a 40-minute bus trip costing \$13.50 each way for seniors. It departs every 30 minutes from outside Door 4 at the Domestic Terminal and offloads at the Hobson St entry to SkyCity. The return is also every 30 minutes from SkyCity [Hobson St entry] to the Domestic Terminal.

You can book tickets online or buy them on the bus either one-way or return from the bus driver. Payment is by card, and luggage is unrestricted. Website - <https://www.skydrive.co.nz>

### Transport - City to Whangaparaoa and vice versa.

The options are either the ferry to Gulf Harbour or the bus to Silverdale. If you have an AT Hop card, these services are free for seniors with a gold AT Hop card. However, the process of obtaining an AT Hop card is problematic for travelers from outside Auckland. For this reason, members of our Club will collect those participants who have flown to Auckland from the SkyCity bus terminus and deliver you to your accommodation in Whangaparaoa. We will also organize transport for your return from Whangaparaoa to the SkyCity bus terminus.

If you would like to try either the ferry or bus options, contact me for further information.

NOTE: Although Whangaparaoa is part of Auckland City, it is too far out for frequent availability of taxis or Ubers around the local area. We will assist with transport to/from the organised events.
